Pope Francis has unveiled a plan to transition Vatican City to solar energy as its primary source of electricity in his latest motu proprio "Fratello Sole" or "Brother Sun."

Thanks to a unique photovoltaic plant installed on the roof of the Vatican Audience Hall, the Papal State has been producing 300 MWh of solar energy every year since its installation in 2008.

Vatican City's solar panels provide a significant portion of the energy needed for key buildings like the Paul VI Audience Hall, demonstrating a strong commitment to transitioning to renewable energy.

Italy has agreed to a Vatican plan to turn a 430-hectare (1,000-acre) plot of land north of Rome into a vast solar farm that will generate enough electricity to meet the needs of Vatican...

Vatican City, the seat of Catholic papacy, has completed its move to solar-powered energy following the completion of its agrivoltaic plant situated on the Holy See's property at Santa ...

A solar panel system is being built on the 424 hectares of extraterritorial land in Ponte Galeria, which within a year will make the Holy See the first zero-emission state in the world.

On the same site, the new solar infrastructure now stands. By May 29th, 2025, that vision was fulfilled, and
